APPLICATION

I. Overall instructions

All applicants for the LEAD MK Fellowship Program must fully complete the application package. USAID's Civic Engagement Project will accept applications only in English. The application package should include:

- a. The completed and signed Application Form;
- b. The applicant's CV that includes the his/her volunteer experience (in English);
- c. Two recommendations from teachers, CSO or community leaders, or other persons that can testify to the applicant's potential for becoming a successful LEAD MK Fellow (in English or local languages).

LEAD MK is a yearlong program consisting of the following components:

- 1. LEAD MK Academy (October 30 November 6, 2019): 7-day residential training program;
- **2. LEAD MK Mentorship Program (November 2019 June 2020):** Assigning of mentors and providing organizational support for LEAD MK small-scale projects;
- 3. Orientation session and training for guidelines and procedures for the implementation of LEAD MK small-scale projects (January 24, 2020)
- **4. Implementation of LEAD MK small-scale projects (February July 2020):** Awarding in-kind grants and individual stipends for implementation of LEAD MK fellows' initiatives.

Please note that if you are selected, you should commit to all program components.

Applications can be mailed, e-mailed, or hand-delivered. Faxed and/or incomplete applications will not be accepted.

Please submit your applications to <u>applications@nms.org.mk</u>. E-mails must have "CFA # CEP-LEAD MK-04" in the subject line. The deadline for submitting the application is **12:00 o'clock noon**, **October 4**, **2019**.
